SAVE YOUR HOME PROGRAM

PURPOSE:

The Allegheny County Residential Mortgage Foreclosure Diversion Program, also known as the Save Your Home Program, helps homeowners facing foreclosure find a path toward housing stability. Launched in 2008 by the Allegheny County Court of Common Pleas, the program aims to prevent home loss through early intervention, legal support, and negotiated resolutions.

Description

The program is a collaborative initiative between the Allegheny County Court of Common Pleas, the Sheriff's Office, and Allegheny County Economic Development (ACED). It provides a structured process for homeowners in mortgage foreclosure to engage with their lenders and explore solutions to retain their homes.

Key features include:

Court-ordered diversion and mediation

Access to housing counselors and legal aid

Assistance navigating repayment options and loan modifications

Program Highlights:

705 homeowners enrolled since inception

592 agreements reached with lenders to avoid foreclosure

Prevents displacement, preserves neighborhoods, and supports long-term housing stability

The Save Your Home Program continues to serve as a vital resource for Allegheny County residents at risk of losing their homes.
